What We Did This Week:

Literacy:

This week in literacy studio we explored theme. We revisited previously read, shared texts and practiced identifying possible themes by thinking about the main character, problem faced, how it was solved, and life lesson learned from it. We discussed how there can be more than one theme, as long as it can support it with viable, text evidence. Additionally, our writing has been focused on writing a personal narrative about a memorable time in our life and adding key details to enhance our stories.
