What We Did This Week:

Literacy: This week we started our imagery unit

on oral storytelling and literature. This

unit focuses on evoking images in a broad

range of fables and folktales, as well as

myths and legends from a wide variety

of cultures. There is also an emphasis on

the art of oral storytelling. In the writing

unit, we will focus on the writing process

as we pre-write, draft, revise, edit, and

publish a short story.

Math Workshop:

This week we focused on concepts in division and have been learning lots of new strategies to reinforce these skills. We completed our unit as we used different properties to solve word problems. Following this unit, we will be learning all about fractions which builds right off of our division unit!

Social Studies/Science:

This week we continued our unit on forces and motion. We looked at the invisible pushes and pulls that operate in the world around us. We also demonstrated the effects of balanced and unbalanced forces on the motion of an object by building bridges.
