What We Did This Week:

Literacy:

This week we practiced using non-fiction texts to research our animals. We discussed how text

features help us as we read and why author's use

- these to help make information easier to understand.
- We really focused on looking critically at bold text and
- determining how to use context clues, as well as
- glossaries to better understand words that we may
- stumble upon. We will continue discussing these
- features as we continue researching our animals. We
- also continued learning about how to summarize what
- we read, as well as how this could be different when
 - summanizing fiction vs. nonfiction.

Math Workshop:

This week we explored arrays, groupings, number lines, and skip counting as strategies to help us multiply. We focused on using the language of multiplication as we became more familiar with what factors are and differentiated between the size of groups and the number of groups within a given context. We also learned how to use a multiplication table as we filled in the factors we already knew. We will continue this unit next week!
